The Citizens Coinage Advisory Committee (CCAC) held a public meeting on February 18, 2025, during which we reviewed the United States Mint's proposal to recognize the twenty-fifth anniversary of the issuance of the Sacagawea Golden Dollar by minting 24k half ounce gold coins featuring the design of the original coin, first released in 2000. The coins will contain the original inscriptions featured on the original coin, and no weight and fineness inscriptions will be added.

By voice vote with seven in favor and two abstaining, the CCAC recommends the production of this anniversary issue of the Sacagawea Golden Dollar.

It is an honor to serve as the Chair of the CCAC and I am proud of the CCAC's role in the production of United States coins and medals.
