Dear Mister Secretary:

The Citizens Coinage Advisory Committee (CCAC) held a public meeting on February 24, 2026, during which the CCAC reviewed the candidate designs for the 2027 American Youth Sport Quarters. *The Circulating Collectible Coin Redesign Act* (Act) (Public Law 116-330) directs the Secretary of the Treasury to redesign and issue up to five quarter dollar coin designs each year from 2027 to 2030 to reflect an American youth sport on the reverse and George Washington on the obverse. The sports for 2027 are snowboarding, golf, softball, baseball, and soccer.

The CCAC, during a previous meeting in November 2025, reviewed and made a recommendation for the candidate design for the common George Washington obverse and was reminded during this meeting of the obverse designs the CCAC and CFA recommended to the Secretary.

At our February 2026 public meeting, the CCAC reviewed and discussed the reverse candidate designs for each of the sports, to include consideration of whether the designs accurately depict the kinematic movement of the sport (e.g., golf swing of a child). Following discussion, the CCAC scored the designs. For two sports, golf and snowboarding, two designs tied with the most points. The CCAC discussed each portfolio separately and specifically focused on the tied designs. Following discussion, a rollcall vote was taken for golf and six members voted to recommend **GOLF-07** and five members voted to recommend **GOLF-02** which both received the highest score of 15 out of 33. The CCAC decided to recommend **GOLF-07**. The CCAC then discussed snowboarding and the tied designs **SNOW-03** and **SNOW-06**, which both received the highest score of 20 out of 33. The CCAC took a rollcall vote with six members recommending **SNOW-03** and five recommending **SNOW-06**. The CCAC decided to recommend **SNOW-03**. The CCAC then made a motion to recommend the highest scored designs for soccer (**SOCC-07** with score of 28 out of 33), softball (**SOFT-04A** with score of 21 out of 33), and baseball (**BASE-01** with score of 22 out of 33). For the recommended baseball reverse of **BASE-01**, the CCAC recommends that the catcher's mask be modified to reflect a more natural placement on the catcher's face.
