The Citizens Coinage Advisory Committee (CCAC) held a public meeting on April 17, 2024, during which they reviewed the candidate designs for the Ventris C. Gibson Director of the Mint medal. As part of its bronze medal portfolio, the United States Mint has historically produced Director of the Mint medals to commemorate the Directors and their legacies. Director Gibson was directly involved in the development of the design portfolio for this medal.

Following a brief discussion, the CCAC unanimously approved a motion to recommended Director Gibson's preferred design candidates **VCG-O-01A** and **VCG-R-01** for the obverse and reverse of the medal.
